<u>Psalms 25:1-6 (NIVUK)</u>

- ¹ In you, Lord my God, I put my trust.
- ² I trust in you; do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me.
- ³ No one who hopes in you will ever be put to shame, but shame will come on those

who are treacherous without cause.

- ⁴ Show me your ways, Lord, teach me your paths.
- ⁵ Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Saviour, and my hope is in you all day long.
- ⁶ Remember, Lord, your great mercy and love, for they are from of old.

I love the wonderful promise in this Psalm - ³ No one who hopes in you will ever be put to shame. As we step into a new year, 2023, it's important to remember that no-one can put us to shame; none of the things we may regret from the last year, or indeed in all of our lives can be held against us when our hope is in the Living God. People might bring up our past, they might try to belittle us, embarrass us, and pull us down, but they can't change the way God sees us, and the forgiveness He gives us through the blood of His Son Jesus.

So, in 2023, be bold in the Lord, and give Him glory in all you do. As the Apostle Paul says, 'Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!'
