#### **From the Study**

#### Romans 13:9-10 (The NIV-UK)

<sup>9</sup> The commandments, 'You shall not commit adultery,' 'You shall not murder,' 'You shall not steal,' 'You shall not covet,' and whatever other command there may be, are summed up in this one command: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.' <sup>10</sup> Love does no harm to a neighbour. Therefore love is the fulfilment of the law.

'Love' is a word taken so much out of context these days, and often used to justify a whole host of things God disagrees with on the basis of the expression 'God is Love'. The New Testament was written in Greek, and the words interpreted 'love' can have specific meanings depending upon the context. When used of God the Greek word for love is agape, which is a perfect love expressed from God to the human race (man), and which is intended we should reciprocate to Him (God); but more than that, it's a love we should share with each other as imitators of God, made in His image.

When the Apostle Paul shares the command, 'Love your neighbour as yourself', he also says, 'Love does no harm to a neighbour'.

In Lent we often give up things, but perhaps this Lent season we could find ways to do more for others, those who cannot do for themselves – showing agape love to our neighbour.


Be blessed and *be a blessing* this month in the mighty name of Jesus,

March may be the time you start thinking about spring cleaning your home. But, before you do, take out your products and have a look at the ingredients listed in them. Most of them will be unpronounceable and the majority of them will have negative effects on the environment. These highly toxic chemicals get washed down the drains and then enter the watercourses and are harmful to wildlife and animals. They can also be harmful to our health as we inhale these chemicals and bleaches over the long term, especially to our respiratory system - they can cause indoor air pollution.

Why not use natural cleaners like lemon juice, bicarbonate of soda, white vinegar and so on - they are just as effective but without the nasties! Search online for more natural cleaning products/ ingredients and you just might be surprised or make a point of buying the Eco-friendly alternatives in the supermarkets. Cheaper is not always better!
