Matthew 6:14-15 (NIV-UK)

¹⁴ For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. ¹⁵ But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Forgiveness of others is probably the greatest challenge for anyone contemplating becoming a Christian – in fact, even when a person does become a Christian, being able to forgive is a huge challenge for many of us.

If you find it difficult to forgive you need to realise that being able to forgive is not always easy, however, forgiveness is nevertheless still essential. I'm aware that many have experienced things which have left physical, psychological or emotional scars – please don't think I'm dismissing those things. In such experiences forgiveness may seem impossible, but I want to remind you of the words of the Apostle Paul (*Philippians 4:13 – Complete Jewish Bible*):

'I can do all things through him who gives me power.'

God is not expecting you to go through the process of forgiving on your own, whatever your experience or challenge, He has given us His Son, Jesus, and the Comforter / Counsellor, the Holy Spirit. Let God lead you in the experience of forgiveness, being forgiven and being able to forgive, for your blessing and His glory.

Be blessed and **be a blessing** this month in the mighty name of Jesus,

Lord Jesus, please teach us the grace of forgiving, even in the most challenging of circumstances; to forgive even as we have been forgiven. Thank You Lord, in Jesus' name, Amen.


Various verses in Genesis say:
